

Consortium Agreement Title IV Student Financial Assistance

Participating Institutions:

University of Arkansas at Fort Smith

The above named institutions of higher education by signature of the Chief Executive Officer of each, hereby agree that courses completed at the University of Arkansas at Fort Smith will be accepted as transfer by The University of Arkansas at Fayetteville provided said courses are acceptable toward a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering or a Bachelor of Science in Electrical Engineering. The University of Arkansas at Fort Smith will be designated as the host institution and will determine financial aid eligibility, disburse funds, and maintain appropriate records as required by law. The University of Arkansas at Fayetteville will be designated as the home institution.

Students seeking a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical or Electrical Engineering from the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville and enrolled in classes at the host institution will apply for financial aid through the host institution. Once the application results are received by the host institution, financial aid will be processed according to standard policies and procedures governing the student financial aid programs at the host institution. Verification and notification of current enrollment status of said students at the host institution will be provided by the Director of Financial Aid of the host school. All financial aid checks will be disbursed by the host institution.

Students receiving Title IV assistance under the terms of this agreement will be subjected to the cost of attendance, satisfactory academic progress, return of Title IV funds, and enrollment policies, as well as other conditions of the financial aid policies and procedures of the host institution. This agreement covers all Title IV student financial assistance programs in which students are eligible to participate.

This consortium agreement between the above-named institutions and will be effective beginning with the 2002-03 academic year. This agreement will be reviewed each academic year, at which time either institution will have the opportunity to terminate or amend the consortium agreement.
